<p>19. History <u>1877 Atlas-Redmond, S.B. nearby grist mill, owned by groom</u></p>																													
<p>20. Significance <u>This single-pile brick structure has elongated windows and molded brick cornice which suggest that it was constructed in the early decades of the 19th century. In 1877 this appeared as the S.B. Redmond House on the Beers Atlas, and may have been part of Groom's (listed on National Register) farm.</u></p>
