
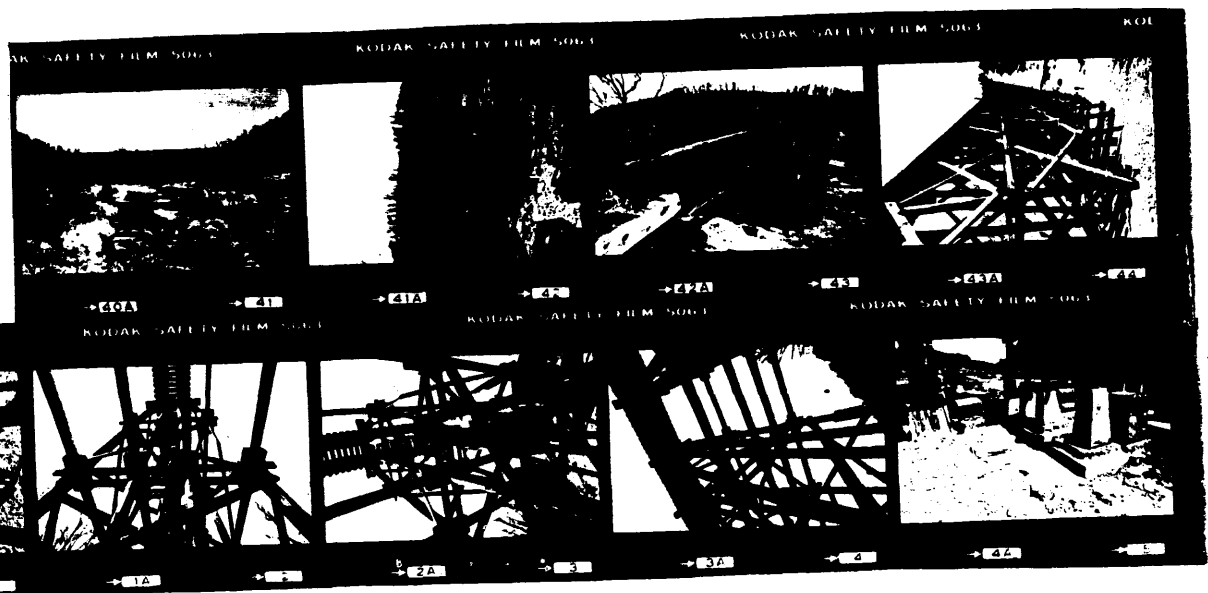

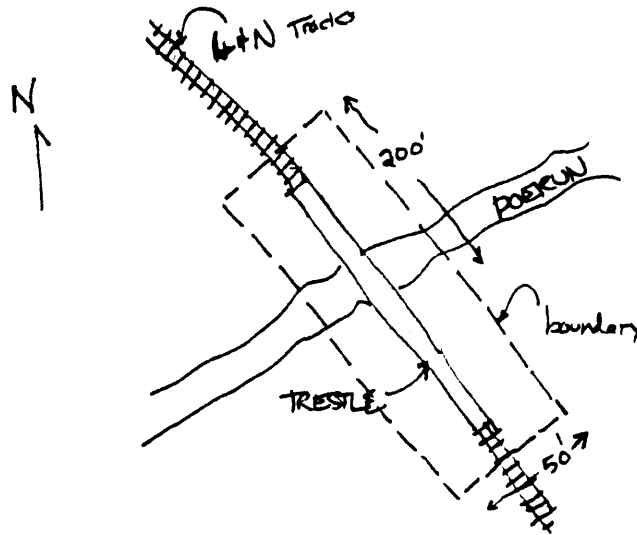
Verbal Boundary Description
