

Describe present and historic physical appearance:

Summary

Located on County Road 402 approximately 6 miles west of Chester in Crawford County, the No. 12 School is a single-story, one-room frame building that was constructed c. 1895 in the Plain Traditional style.

Elaboration

Located on County Road 402 approximately 6 miles west of Chester in Crawford County, the No. 12 School is a single-story, one-room frame building that was constructed c. 1895 in the Plain Traditional style. The structure rests upon a continuous fieldstone foundation, is clad with white-painted false-bevel novelty siding, and is covered by an end gable roof sheathed with corrugated metal. Roof features include the original belfry, a central metal flue, and an interior brick chimney. The belfry is likewise executed in novelty siding and contains louvered ventilators on all four elevations. A low-pitched composition-shingled hipped roof caps the projection.

The front, or western, elevation contains two single-leaf entrances that consist of two-panelled wood doors with wood screen doors. A wooden handicapped access ramp has been placed in front of the southern entrance, while the northern entrance retains a three-step concrete stoop. The northern and southern side elevations are identically arranged with four symmetrically placed two-over-two, double-hung windows with removable wood-frame screens. The rear, or eastern, elevation is not fenestrated.

Inside, the walls and trey ceiling are covered with double-beaded boards. A raised stage is located at the eastern end, and a pulpit also constructed of vertical beaded boards is placed in the center. The original wood flooring is also present. An old cast-iron stove of uncertain vintage is positioned near the center of the floor and is connected by stove pipe with the new metal flue seen from the exterior. The interior end brick chimney is a suspended design and has a wood cabinet built underneath. Otherwise, the interior is furbished with antique school desks and is lighted by six bare light bulbs.

There are no historic outbuildings associated with the school. A modern privy built in 1987 is located nearby, but outside of the boundaries of this nomination.

Summary

The No. 12 School near Chester is being nominated with local significance under Criterion C as the best example in Crawford County of a one-room school building.

Elaboration

Very little is known about the origins and subsequent history of the No. 12 School. It is not mentioned in Clara B. Eno's definitive *History of Crawford County* nor in the Crawford County Bicentennial Commission's "An Historical Salute to Crawford County."

The school is believed to have been constructed in the late 1800's and served as such until consolidation in 1946. Since that time the building has been utilized as a community building and is occasionally used for church services, weddings, and voting. In 1986, the residents in the surrounding community organized and decided to raise funds to repair the rapidly deteriorating structure. The group has since incorporated as the No. 12 Schoolhouse Preservation, Inc.

The No. 12 School is locally significant under Criterion C as an excellent and virtually unaltered example of the traditional one-room frame school construction that was popular throughout the state in the late 1800's and into the first decade of the twentieth century.

Subject: Effect of government shutdown on National Register listing procedures

During the month-long government shutdown, this National Register nomination passed its 45th day due date and was automatically listed in the National Register. This action is governed by the following sections of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1996, as amended:

TITLE 1

Section 101 (16 U.S.C. 470a)

(a)(3) Nominations to the National Register

...Subject to paragraph (6), any property nominated under this paragraph or under section 110(a)(2) shall be included on the National Register on the date forty-five days after receipt by the Secretary of the nomination and the necessary documentation, unless the Secretary disapproves such nomination within such forty-five day period or unless an appeal is filed under paragraph (5).

(a)(6) Owner participation in nomination process

...If the owner or owners of any privately owned property, or a majority of the owners of such properties within the district in the case of an historic district, object to such inclusion or designation, such property shall not be included on the Nation Register or designated as a National Historic Landmark until such objection is withdrawn.

As a result of the government shutdown, any nomination that was date stamped received and that was at the National Register 45 days between December 18 and January 11 is listed in the National Register as of the 45th day, even if the nomination was not entered in the NRIS, published in the Federal Register for comment, or reviewed.

This does not apply to nomination appeals, nominations where a majority of private owners have objected to listing that are to be determined eligible, or requests for determinations of eligibility from Federal agencies.




