The Kemp Avenue Bridge is located in the City of Watertown and carries Kemp Avenue over the Sioux River. The five-span, metal multiplate, arch bridge rests on concrete piers and abutments. The spandrels are of randomly laid, pink and gray granite. Each arch has ring stones and three keystones. The spandrels are separated from the granite railings by the concrete deck. The railings are capped with concrete. Light fixture cavities are located in the second and fifth posts on each side of the bridge, but are missing the original grilles. A concrete sidewalk is located on both sides of the bridge.

The bridge retains excellent integrity.

The Kemp Avenue Bridge is being nominated to the National Register as part of the "Historic Bridges in South Dakota" Multiple Property Nomination. It is related to the historic context of "Historic Bridges in South Dakota, 1893-1942" and is classified with the associated property type for multi-plate arch bridges. This bridge is individually eligible for the National Register under Criterion A for its association with the New Deal public works program, designed to provide work relief for the nation's unemployed during the Great Depression of the 1930s and early 1940s. The bridge is also individually eligible under Criterion C as a rare example in South Dakota of a multi-plate arch bridge, and for its fine stone masonry craftsmanship. The bridge retains excellent integrity.

President Roosevelt's New Deal programs of the 1930s, ushered in a new era of bridge construction in the South Dakota. The primary intent of these programs was to provide federal assistance to put as many men to work as possible during a time of severe economic crisis, the Great Depression. For bridge projects, in general, federal agencies paid for labor, while the state or local highway departments paid for supervision, engineering, and materials. Most assistance for bridge construction in South Dakota was provided by the Works Progress Administration (WPA) which supervised the bulk of New Deal work-relief projects from 1935 to the onset of World War II in 1942.

The Kemp Avenue Bridge was designed by the South Dakota State Highway Commission and erected in 1935 as a U.S. Public Works project. The multi-plate arch design of this bridge enjoyed a very brief period of popularity, confined almost entirely to the decade of the 1930s. During its heyday, however, the multi-plate arch seems to have provided a viable alternative to reinforced-concrete slab-and-girder construction for shortspan bridges. The simple modular design of multi plate construction made it an ideal choice for the unskilled, work-relief projects of the New Deal era. At the same time, multi-plate bridge design, by easily assimilating masonry or concrete headwalls and spandrels, satisfied New Deal priorities for roadside beautification and the encouragement of local craft skills.

The Kemp Avenue Bridge is one of only two multi-plate arch bridges found to exist in South Dakota by the state wide inventory of historic bridges. Both of the bridges reflect the New Deal agenda of promoting highway beautification, local craft skills, and labor-intensive public works projects. The Kemp Avenue Bridge, however, has added significance because of the high degree of craftsmanship exhibited by its stone masonry work.
