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#### Description

The Watkins House is a two story, wood frame Colonial Revival residence with Craftsman style influences. A single story, hipped roof room on the western elevation is balanced by a single story, hipped roof carport on the eastern elevation--both are original--and emphasize the symmetrical, rectangular plan of the main block of the house. An exterior end brick chimney is attached to the western wall of the house and an interior brick chimney rises through the north shed dormer, to the east of center. The roof material is composition shingle, the walls are covered with original stucco, and the structure is supported upon a continuous brick foundation. Almost all the windows are framed by a pair of simple, louvered shutters, painted white.

The southern or front elevation of the main house is composed of the first story wall below the gambrel roof and the tall, full-length shed dormer above. The single door entry is sheltered by a rounded shed porch roof supported on decorative sawn wood brackets. Two pair of six-over-six wood sash windows flank the doorway on the first floor and two identical six-over-six wood sash windows are symmetrically placed around a smaller, central six-over-six wood sash window in the shed dormer. The western, single story wing is lighted with a pair of six-over-six wood sash windows, and the eastern carport is open and supported on a pair of large, stuccoed corner piers. All of the cornices are decorated with thin, short brackets which resemble exposed rafters.

The western elevation is composed of the single story, hipped roof addition on the first floor and the chimney rising through the center of the main wall behind, dividing the end of both the gambrel roof and the shed dormers. The shed dormers feature short returns, decorated with thin brackets, and two six-over-six wood sash windows flank the chimney on the second floor. The single story wing is lighted with two pair of symmetrically-placed six-over-six wood sash windows. The eastern elevation is punctuated with a central attic vent beneath the roof peak and is fenestrated with two symmetrically-placed six-over-six wood sash windows on the second story. Two six-over-six wood sash windows are placed in the center and to the north of the first floor and a pair of six-over-six wood sash windows lights the southern end, beneath the carport. The gambrel roof's returns and the carport are decorated with thin comice brackets.

The second story of the northern or rear elevation is fenestrated with two six-over-six wood sash windows symmetrically-placed around a central, eight-over-eight wood sash window. A central pair of six-over-six wood sash windows in the first floor is flanked to the west by a larger pair of six-over-six wood sash windows and to the east by a single sash window and an entry. The western, single story wing is punctuated by an entry and a single six-over-six wood sash window.

The Watkins House has been virtually unaltered since its construction date and is in excellent condition.

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Significance

Criterion C, local significance

The Watkins House (Part E, Historic Context #4) is one of two surviving Colonial Revival residences in Searcy. Like the Lightle House, the selection of the gambrel roof and the overall characteristics of symmetry and balance combine with such details as the six-over-six wood sash windows to reveal the obvious influence of the Colonial Revival style; and yet, here also the growing influence of the Craftsman style is exhibited in the false exposed rafters which decorate the cornices throughout this building. The Watkins House is symbolic of the rapid influx of the myriad architectural fashions that characterized the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries and which were to be expected in a growing city and county seat.
