

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION

The Peter House is a two-and-a-half-story wood frame structure of asymmetrical massing on a rectangular floor plan. Overall dimensions of the house are approximately 40 feet by 35 feet. The roof is hipped with an off center gable. Horizontal siding is used on the vertical exterior surfaces. Exterior details include fan light windows in the gables, decorative brick work on the chimneys, vertically patterned mullions in the windows, and a two-story porch.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

C.A. Peter was cashier at the Bank of Arizona at the time he built his home on Union Street. The house is one of four large residences designed in the later phase of the Queen Anne style which were built on Union Street between Union and Alarcon.
