



THE WILKES COUNTY COURTHOUSE, WASHINGTON, GA. is one of the best examples of Romanesque Gothic Architecture in America. Clock in town refused to run 1865 when Federal Troops quartered there. Records in Courthouse date from 1777. Historic markers on lawn. Site of famous Heard Building, last meeting place of Confederate Cabinet.
