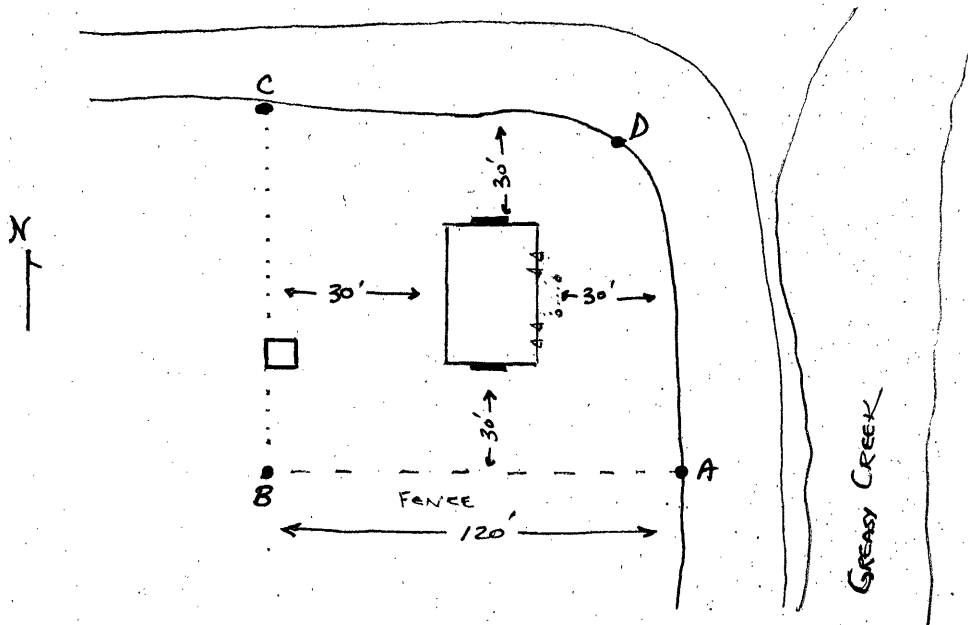

Verbal Boundary Description Acreage @ .33 ACRE

Bounded on East and North by Road, on South by fence and on West by an imaginary line created by the rear property line of the smokehouse approximately 30' to the rear of the house.

Beginning at point A 40' from the SE corner of the house; thence W along a fence 120' to point B; thence N along a fence 120' to point C on the edge of a county road; thence along the county road E 120' to point D; thence S along the county road to the beginning.
