On the 1st of June 1864, the  
British Government, by an Order  
in Council, has directed that  
the following regulations should be  
observed in the management of  
the public affairs of the Colony.

The first of these regulations  
is, that the Governor should  
be empowered to appoint and  
dismiss all the public officers,  
and to grant them such salaries  
as he may think fit.

The second regulation is, that  
the Governor should be authorized  
to make such laws as he may  
deem necessary for the good  
government of the Colony.

The third regulation is, that  
the Governor should be empowered  
to grant pardons and reprieves  
in all cases, except in those  
where the death sentence has  
been pronounced.
