The First Methodist Church was designed by one of the major mid-nineteenthcentury Wisconsin architects; Edward Townsend Mix (1831-1890) of Milwaukee. Mix was the architect for several National Register buildings and nominations in Wisconsin, including Villa Louis at Prairie du Chien (National Historic Landmark), and Milwaukee's Mitchell Building, Mackie Building, All Saint's Cathedral, Immanuel Presbyterian Church, and St. Paul's Episcopal Church. Born in New Haven, Connecticut, he there met Richard Upjohn, for whom Mix worked for seven years before moving west. For one year he worked for William Boyington in Chicago, and then moved to Milwaukee where, in 1856, he established his own office. He worked in many major post-Civil War styles, including the late Gothic Revival, High Victorian Gothic, High Victorian Italianate, Second Empire, and Richardsonian Romanesque. Since the records of his office have been lost or destroyed, the extent of Mix's practice is unknown outside of The last months of Mix's life were spent in Minneapolis, Milwaukee. where he retired for his health before dying, apparently of tuberculosis, in 1890. For over thirty years Mix practiced architecture in Wisconsin and rose to the position of one of the most famous and significant of the state's nineteenth-century practitioners.

Monroe's First Methodist Church, built over an eighteen-year period, is an excellent late Gothic Revival building and the city's most significant religious structure. It is in the same generic vein as others of Mix's church oeuvres, bearing a striking resemblance to a mirror-image of his St. Luke's Church in Racine and Whitewater's Methodist Church, also probably by Mix. In Monroe, however, the church stands out as a unique local Mix design: a major architect's commission in a small, pastoral community. The primary area of significance, therefore, is indicated as "architecture."

Secondarily, the building is significant in the field of "religion/ philosophy" due to the antiquity of the congregation which erected the building. It was built by the first religious congregation in Green County on property deeded to the group in 1842. Founded in 1839 by the Reverend James Ash, Monroe's early Methodist congregation built its first church building in 1843 on the site of the present parsonage. The present church was erected behind a former parsonage, since demolished, and the present parsonage was erected following the removal of the original church. Thus the site of the church is significant historically as the location of the county's first religious organization.
