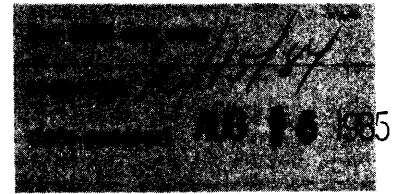

Description: Built in 1895, the Bronston Post Office is a two-story rectangular frame structure. It is a gable-end building three bays wide by four bays deep with weatherboard siding. The windows are two-over-two sash with a glass vent window in the gable field of the main facade. On the second floor is a frame and glass paneled door on the north elevation which once led to a stairway. Beneath the standing seam metal roof are exposed rafters. A one-story storage shed is attached to the rear.

Significance: Bronston is a small community which has retained an identifiable character centering upon the post office. Most other similar communities in the county have lost their original buildings which made up the community center. The Bronston Post Office is a relatively unaltered vernacular frame building constructed in 1895. It was built by Sam David Newell whose family has been associated with Bronston since the early 19th century. The building continues to be utilized as a post office and store and it is one of the best maintained rural commercial structures in the county.

Acreage: Approximately .6 acre.

Verbal Boundary Description: The boundary of the post office is defined on the west by the eastern edge of Kentucky Highway 790, on the north by the southern boundary of the Burnside-Bronston road, on the east by the easternmost edge of an adjacent parking area and on the south by the property boundary line.

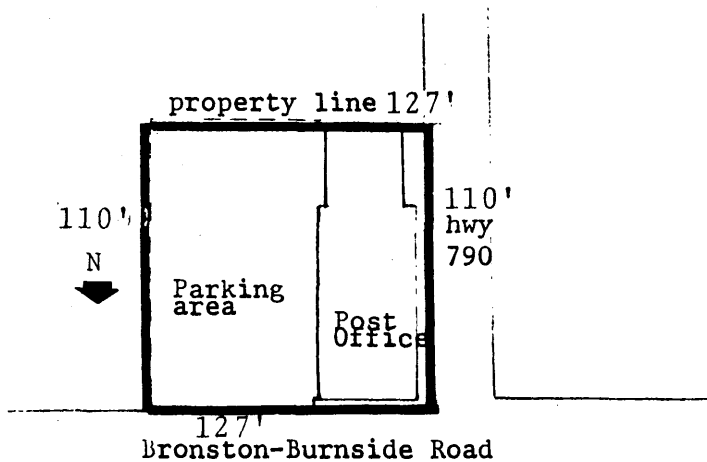
