## Narrative Description (Describe the historic and current condition of the property on one or more continuation sheets.)

The Thayer Lake North Shelter Cabin is a three-sided Adirondack style shelter cabin that was part of the Admiralty Island Canoe Route, a Civilian Conservation Corps project in southeast Alaska during the 1930s. It has a peeled log superstructure and shake walls and roof.

The U.S. Forest Service maintains the cabin. It will need major attention soon. All the sill logs are rotten, and moisture is seeping up the bottoms of the posts and angle braces, staining and weathering the bottom ten inches or so. Wall shakes are thirty inches long and abut vertically. New shakes were put on the roof in the early 1980s. None of the roof or wall shakes is original. The front of the shelter does not have shakes protecting the ends of the horizontal poles used as nailers for the wall shakes. Short chunks of wood five inches in diameter seal the back of the wall where it meets the roof line.

The shelter cabin looks out over Thayer Lake. The natural context is similar to what it was in the 1930s. The ruin of a modest bridge consisting of a log with a few shakes nailed to it spans a narrow stream channel about seventy-five feet from the cabin. It is a contributing structure.

Narrative Statement of Significance (Explain the significance of the property on one or more continuation sheets.)

The Thayer Lake North Shelter Cabin is a three-sided Adirondack shelter cabin built by the Civilian Conservation Corps along the Admiralty Island Canoe Route. It is a good example of the Adirondack style recreation shelters that were popular during the 1930s. A little log bridge, part of the canoe route, is also part of the site.

The cabin is in a natural environment unchanged from the 1930s. The building has been maintained with materials similar to those used originally and maintains its architectural integrity.
