

#### Physical Description

This two-story building designed by Charles Thompson around 1908 represents the most stylish and impressive version of several similar small-town commercial structures. A corner site with the recessed entrance of the building placed on the diagonal and flanked by two wings forms the principal arrangement for these designs. This building, located on a corner of Fordyce's Main Street, features a prominent corner tower capped by terra-cotta domical roof with finials. Its rich facade faced with gray-brown brick features brick bands resembling rustication along the second story. On the ground floor stone pilasters with simple molded capitals frame large plate glass windows. On the second story pilasters with Ionic capitals align with the plainer pilasters below. Alternating circular and rectangular decorative metal vents pierce the attic level. A stone cornice with modillions adds to the decorative flair. Above this rises the parapet with stone coping. The arched entrance porch at the corner features large masonry blocks and a free-standing granite column with attic base on high stone plinth which supports the corner. The capital of this column is over-scaled and carved in a fanciful foliate design. The beveled glass double leaf door is crowned by an arched transom with leaded glass cames. The ceramic tiles of the porch floor spell out the name of the building: "Fordyce Home Accident Insurance Company! A secondary entrance leading to offices upstairs is located at the end of the Main Street block.

#### Statement of Significance

The Fordyce Home Accident Insurance Company in Southern Arkansas was designed by Charles L. Thompson in 1908. This building is representative of the most elaborate version of several small-town commercial structures. As in the Bank of Waldo (CO-008) and the Bank of Carthage (DA-013), the Fordyce Home Accident Insurance Company features a recessed corner entrance. All three of these southern Arkansas commercial structures were built for a Mr. A. B. Banks, a local entrepreneur. The two-story building in Fordyce is of brick construction and features an impressive corner tower capped by a terra-cotta domical roof with finials. The building is basically Queen Anne in massing with some Romanesque details in the squat columns supporting the entrance portico, stone voussoirs, and classic pilasters.
