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The Capa Bridge is located 15.7 miles north and 9.8 miles west of Murdo, 3 miles east of Capa, and carries a local road over the Bad River. The bridge has one main span and seven approach spans; the main span (127 feet) is a steel riveted, pratt through truss, and the five west and two east approach spans are wood stringers. The main span sits on two concrete piers, while the east approach spans sit on the concrete pier, a wood pile bent and a wood pile abutment with plank backwalls and wing walls. The five west approach spans rest on the concrete pier, four wood pile bents, and a wood pile abutment. The main span is comprised as follows: the upper chords consist of two steel channel sections riveted with a continuous steel cover plate along their upper flanges and lacing bars riveted along their lower flanges; the lower chords consist of two paired steel angle channel sections riveted with lacing bars; the diagonals consist of two steel angle sections riveted with batten plates. The concrete deck is poured to encase the top portion of the steel I-beam stringers and steel I-beam floor beams. The stringers are riveted to the webs of the floor beams which in turn are riveted to gusset plate atop the lower chord. The portal bracing consists of steel angle sections. The sway bracing consists of lacing bars between paired angle sections, with knee braces. Both top and bottom lateral bracing consists of angle section cross bracing. Two steel angle sections comprise the railing along each side of the bridge.

The bridge retains excellent integrity.

8. Significance

Bridge no. 38-072-033 is being nominated to the National Register of Historic Places as part of the "Historic Bridges in South Dakota" Multiple Property Nomination. It is related to the historic context of "Historic Bridges in South Dakota, 1893-1943" and is classified with the associated property type for iron and steel frame bridges. This bridge is individually eligible for the National Register under Criterion A for its association with the decision of Jones County to build its own bridges. Bridge No. 38-072-033 is also eligible under Criterion C as a rare example of a riveted Pratt through truss built before the 1920s in South Dakota.

On April 1, 1919 bids were received on this bridge as well as 12 other county bridges from The Federal Bridge Company, J.E. Houseman, The Illinois Bridge Company, and G.W. England. On April 10, 1919, all bids were rejected and the commissioners instructed the County Superintendent of Highways to build all bridges for which the county had plans on file. On August 2, 1919, the commissioners moved that the superintendent finish all bridges for which supplies were on hand, then cease construction on all other planned bridges. On January 6, 1920, the county auditor was instructed to advertise for bids for county bridges. A bridge at the location of No. 38-072-033 was not included and was not again mentioned in the commissioners proceedings, suggesting that this bridge was built by a county crew, although it would have been a major undertaking.

Bridge No. 38-072-033 was built in 1919 during an era of transition in the types of metal truss bridges built in South Dakota. Prior to this time, the pin-connected Pratt was the most widely used bridge type in the state. After about 1910, however, the riveted connection replaced the pin-connection as standard practice and, until about 1920, the riveted Warren truss became more frequently used for small spans, although the pin-connected Pratt remained the preferred type for longer spans. Bridge no. 38-072-033 represents an important experiment in bridge design during this era because of the use of riveted connections rather than pinconnections for a Pratt through type bridge. It is one of only two riveted Pratt through trusses documented as pre-1920 to be identified by the statewide inventory of historic bridges in South Dakota.
