ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION

The Moore House is a two-story single pile gable-roofed woodfrane structure with two-story shed-roofed front porch and one-story shed-roofed kitchen addition (1941) to the rear (south). Only the first story of the house dated to 1856; the upstairs was added in 1896 after the house was extended to the south three years earlier in 1893 to create an attached kitchen. The original single pile is raised on a stone foundation wall and terminates with stone chimneys in the gable ends. The central hall plan of the 1856 section of the house retains its integrity and is reflected in the articulation of the symmetrical facade's central single-leaf entrance with transom and sidelights. Of particular note is the survival of the house's original stone fireplace and its Federal-influenced mantelboard. Three log outbuildings are extant on the house site.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Members of the Moore family have occupied the Moore House continuously since 1833. Although the exterior of the building presents virtually none of the fabric that characterized the house at the time of its 1856 construction, the survival of the interior character of the original single pile and the occupants of this site in the town plan at the early date are of significance. A log structure, described by the building's owner as a late nineteenth-century grainery, located to the southwest of the potential for this property to yield historical archeological information also warrants recognition.
