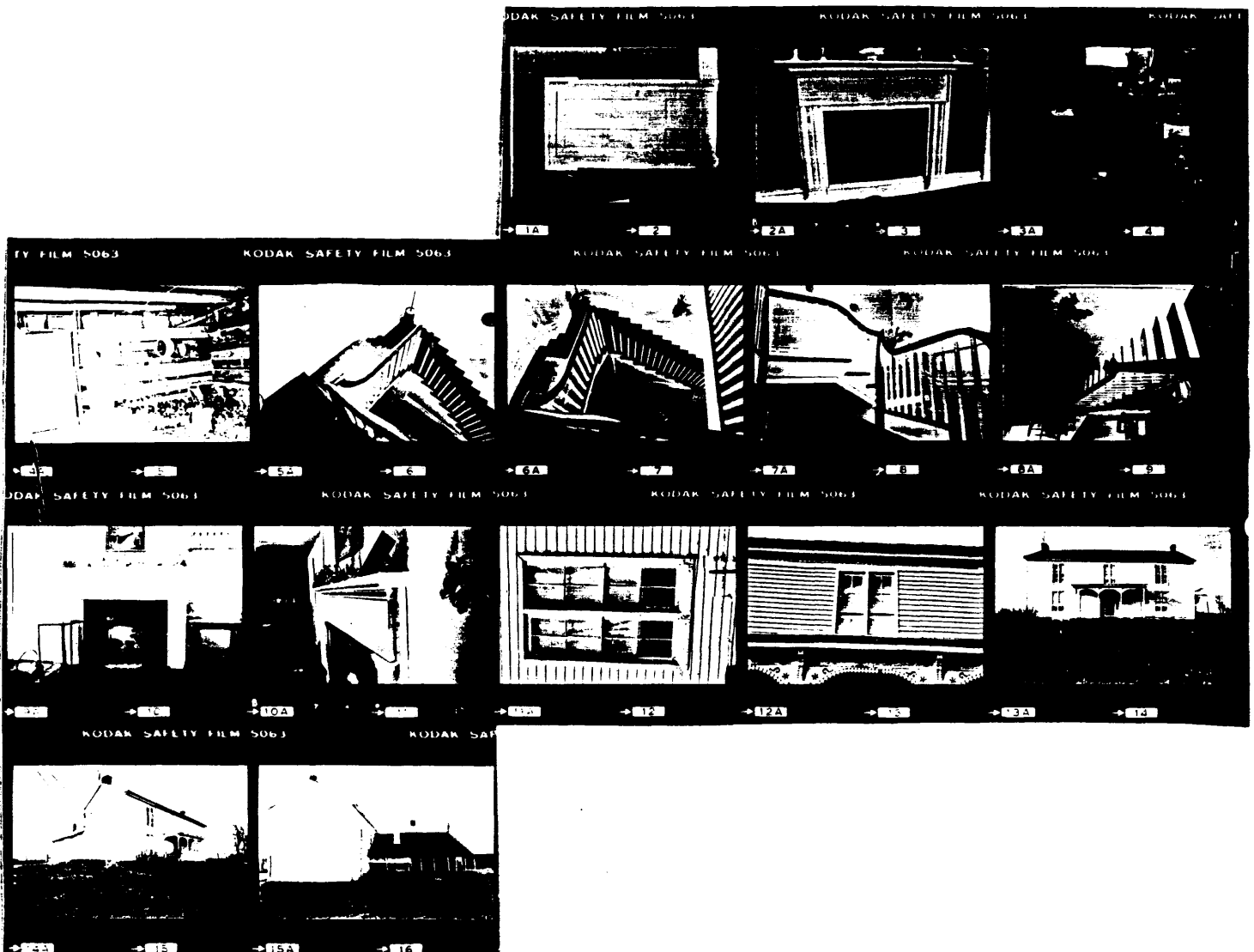


DESCRIPTION: (cont.) under eaves; internal end chimneys;

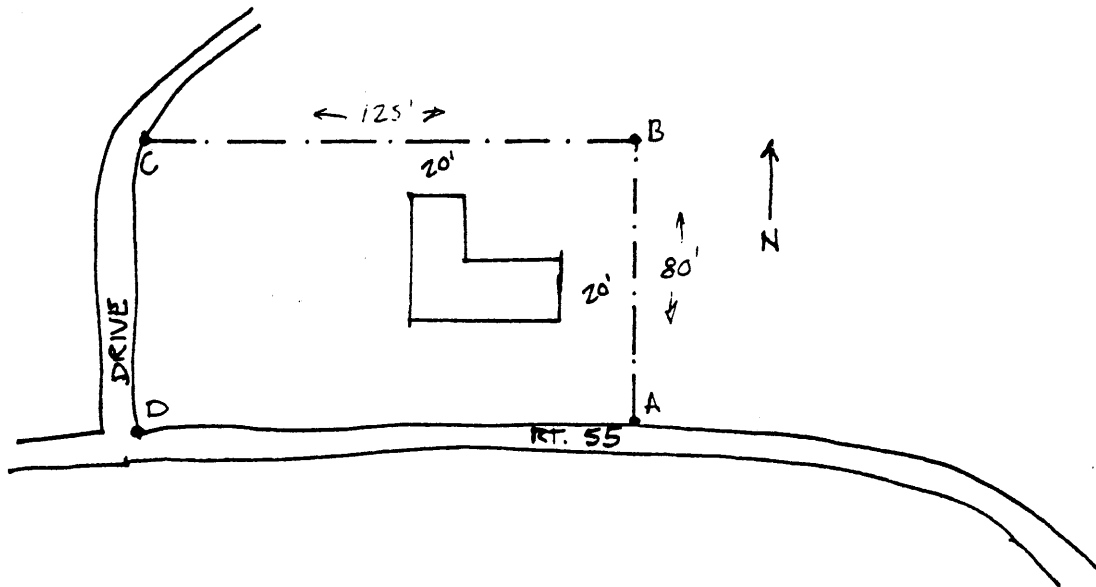

Verbal Boundary Description Acreage 0.23 acre

Beginning at point A on the north side of Ky 55, north with a fence 80 feet to point B, west along fence 125 feet to point C on drive on west side of house, south along east side of drive 80 ft. to point D, thence 125 feet east on side Ky 55 to point of origin. The boundaries were drawn to include the house and domestic-related space as enclosed by fences and the highway. There are no outbuildings.

The nominated area includes one contributing building.
