

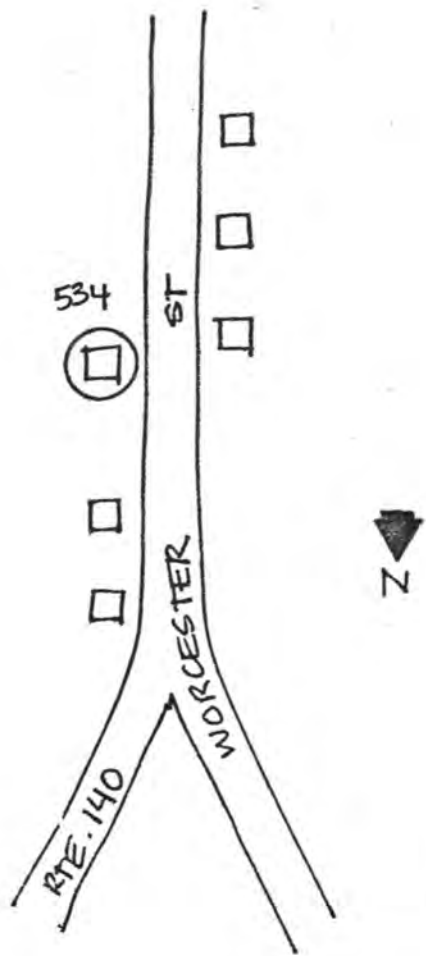

9. Historical significance (include explanation of themes checked above)

Possibly significant for its association with the Hodges Family, prominent settlers of Oakland, this is one of the best local examples of a Greek Revival Classic Cottage that retains all period details.

Description: The 1½-story Classic Cottage has 5 symmetrical bays on the facade, and an entrance enframing consisting of pilasters supporting an entablature, inscribing narrow sidelights. This motif is repeated at the house's corners, where pilasters carry a roof entablature. 2/2 sash windows appear throughout. The house has a small 1½-story recessed wing.

The Hodges House possesses integrity of location, design, setting, materials, workmanship and association. It meets criterion C of the National Register of Historic Places for its significance as the best preserved example of a fully developed Greek Revival style cottage in Taunton.

Boundaries are confined to the house itself and 12' of land measured out from the foundation on all sides.

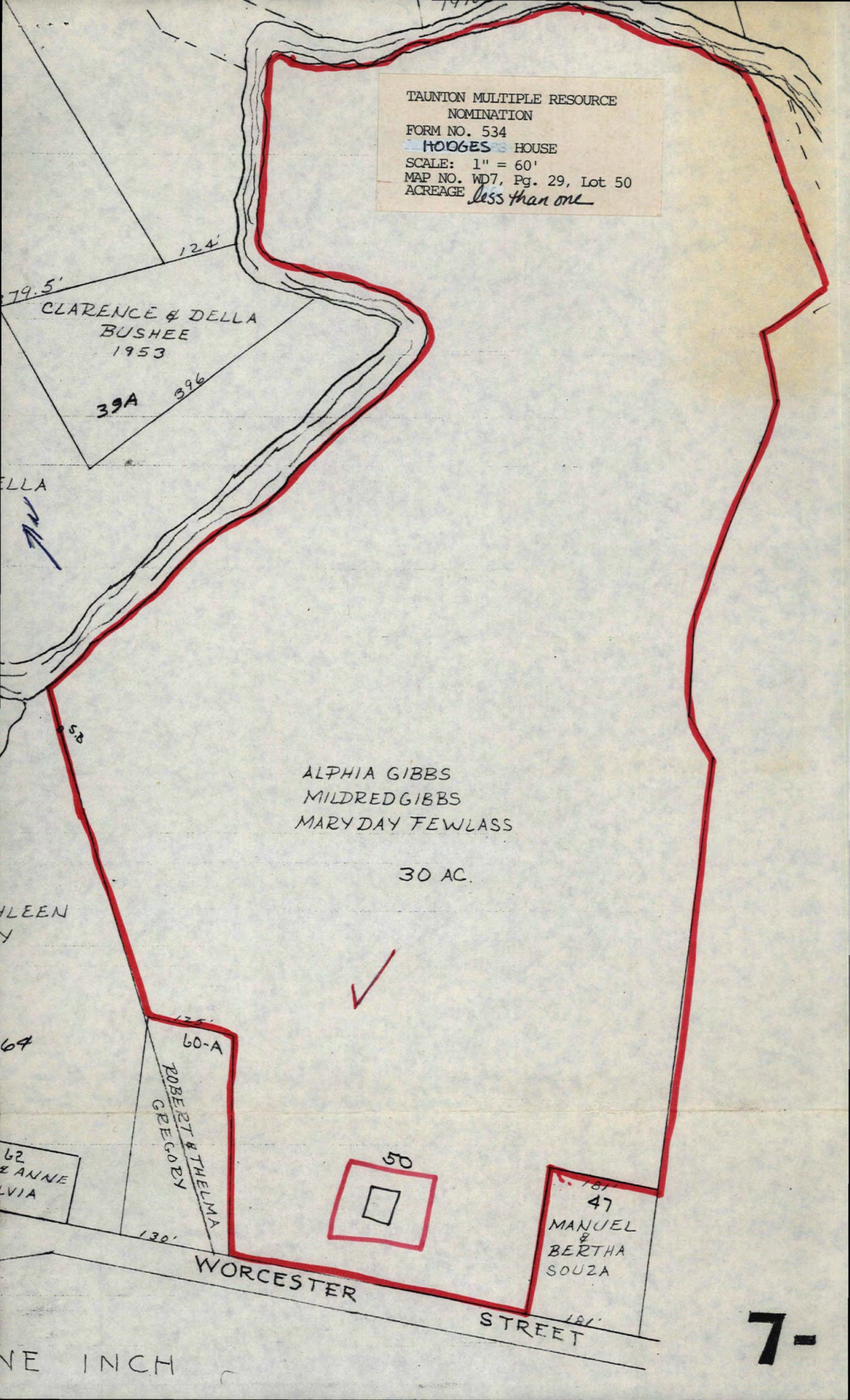

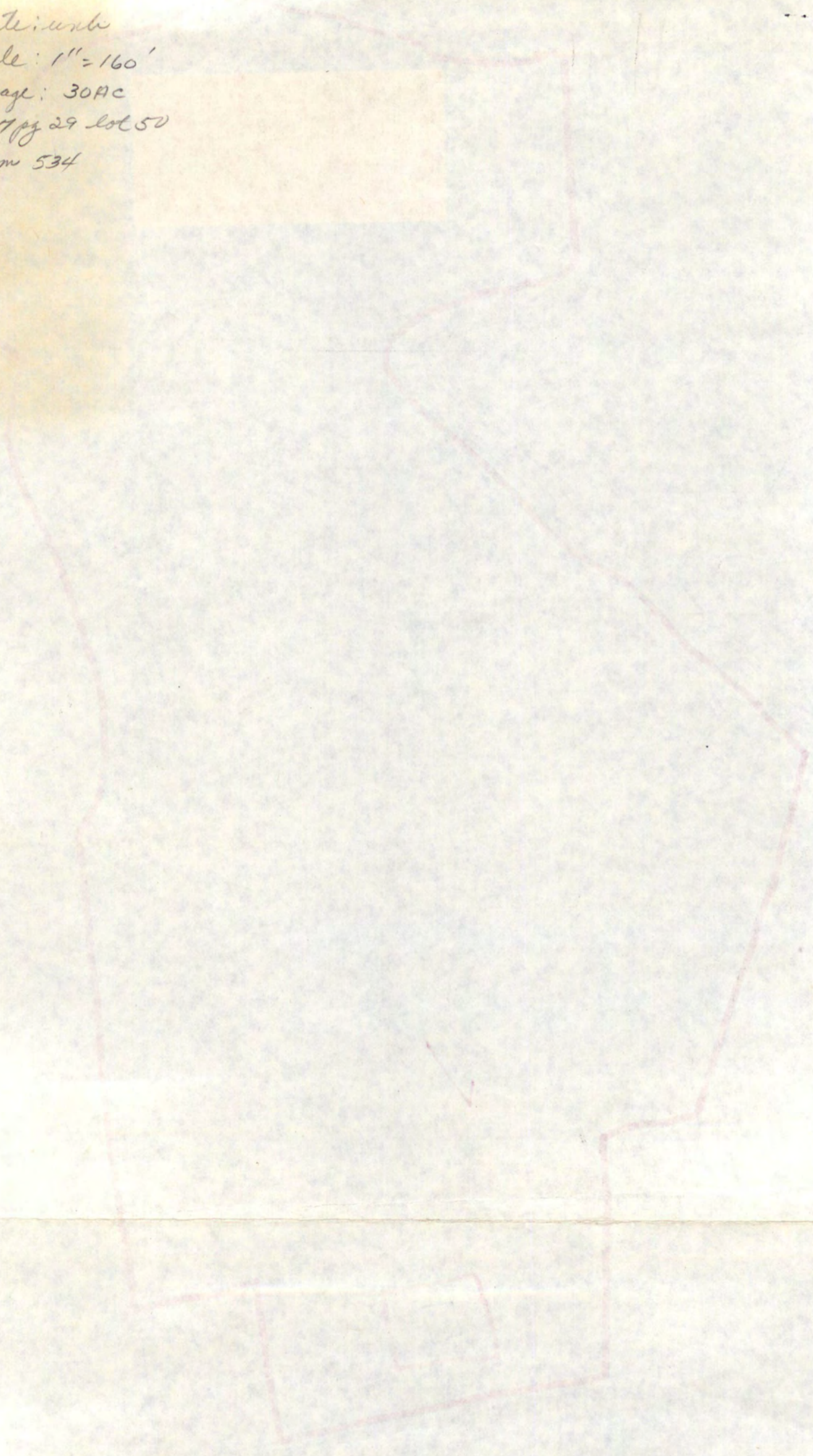
