The interior, which also survives in nearly unchanged condition, shows ample evidence of careful craftsmanship. The living room fireplace, the work of a local mason of Finnish descent named Saari, is surrounded by an entire wall of raised field panelling.

The house is set amidst foundation plantings and is approached by a curving walkway which passes to the left of a round fieldstone well.

The property includes several outbuildings the most important of which is an L-shaped one story barn complete with picturesque wood stave silo. Built on the foundation of an earlier barn, this complex's siting across a large open area from the house to its east forms, with an enclosed garden area and small shed to the north, a barn yard arrangement of separate yet spatially related structures. This locally well accepted alternative to "additive architecture," used here in an effort to capture the spirit of an early hill farm, can be seen in its original form at HRD-1A, the Abijah Twitchell Homestead.

A small shed southeast of the main house and a guest house in the style of the main house next to a vertical board modern garage along the westerly entrance road complete the property's building inventory.




