Bridge No. 39-006-070 carries an unpaved road across Pearl Creek about 4 miles north of Iroquois. This 23-foot structure is a single-span, reinforced-concrete, deck, segmental-arch bridge with flared, sloping wing walls. Springing approximately from grade level, the arch has a clear span of 20 feet. The spandrel walls of each elevation are divided into two, mirror-image recessed panels bounded by a coping along the top of the elevation, a pronounced arch band along the bottom, and a keystone-like device at the center, joining arch band to coping. The coping rises above the roadway to form low curbs that once supported pipe-metal railings, now removed. The alteration has not significantly affected the bridge's integrity.

8. Significance

Bridge no. 39-006-070 is being nominated to the National Register of Historic Places as part of the "Historic Bridges in South Dakota" Multiple Property Nomination. It is related to the historic context of "Historic Bridges in South Dakota, 1893-1943" and is classified with the associated property type for reinforced concrete highway bridges. This bridge is individually eligible for the National Register under Criterion C as an early example of a concrete deck arch in the state and as the only surviving bridge by South Dakota bridge builder, R.S. Warner. The bridge retains excellent integrity.

By the early 1910s reinforced concrete came into use in South Dakota for the construction of bridges. The earliest concrete bridges in South Dakota were built in the southeastern portion of the state, and many, if not all of these structures were professionally designed. However, while the construction of steel bridges had been monopolized by out-of-state firms, these same out-of-state steel bridge companies never seemed to monopolize the concrete bridge building market. Instead, many local contractors successfully competed in this aspect of the bridge building business.

Bridge No. 39-006-070 appears to be the first concrete bridge authorized and built by Kingsbury County. According to County Commissioners records, the board approved the bridge in April 1911. That same July, the board awarded a \$600 construction contract for the structure to low bidder R.S. Warner, who completed the project by December. It is not known if Warner supplied his own plans. Although Warner built another concrete bridge for the county in 1912, that structure is no longer standing. As one of the earliest concrete arch bridges in South Dakota, Bridge No. 39-006-070 represents the earliest, prestandardization, experimental era in reinforced-concrete bridge construction.
