Description

Located on Highway 309 at its crossing of a tributary of Cove Creek (approximately 8.5 miles southeast of Paris and approximately 1/2 mile southeast of the junction of Highway 309 and County Road 53), the Cove Creek Tributary Bridge is of the stone masonry, closed spandrel arch type. The two arches each span a distance of 11 feet and the overall length is 23 feet. The deck measures 29 feet in width and the overall width is 32 feet. The entire bridge is of structural stone masonry construction with a deck composed of asphalt over a concrete subsurface. A later solid concrete barrier runs along both sides of the deck.

Significance

Constructed in 1936, the Cove Creek Tributary Bridge is associated with the *Arkansas Highway* and *Transportation Era* historic context and is of the stone masonry, closed spandrel arch type. Though the identity of its original designer does not survive, it was constructed in conjunction with the Arkansas State Highway Commission and thus may well have been designed by one of that state agency's engineers. Given its relatively intact condition it retains sufficient integrity to remain associated with its historic period and is thus locally eligible under Criterion C.
