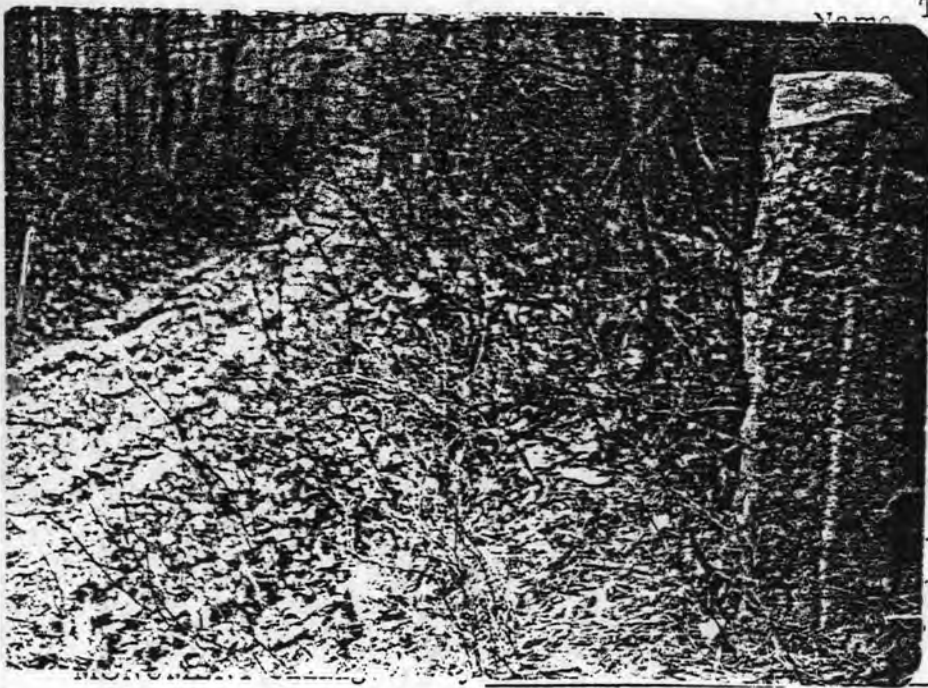

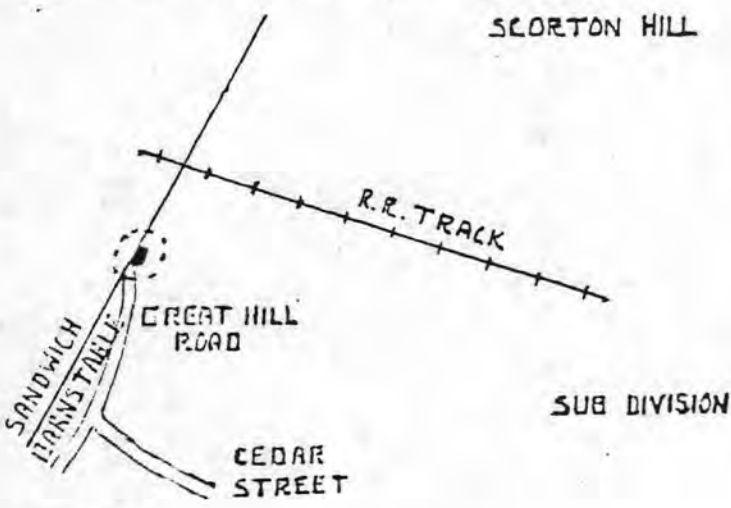

GIVE A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF SUBJECT MATTER AND/OR DESIGN OF MONUMENT

The stone marks the boundry line between the Towns of Barnstable and Sandwich. The letter B, on the right side of the vertical line chiseled up the middle of the marker, stands for the Town of Barnstable. The letter S on the left side stands for the Town of Sandwich. The date of erection is unknown.

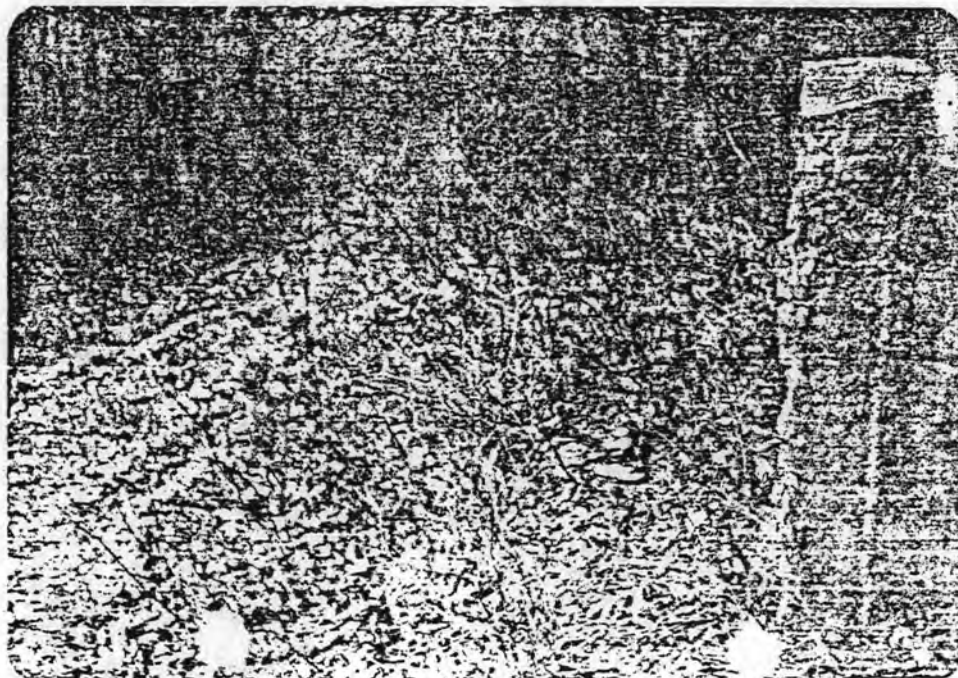
The marker is located on the boundry line between the Towns of Barnstable and Sandwich basically set when the settlers purchased most of what is now West Barnstable from the Indian Chief Serunk in 1644.

Criteria

Although the precise date of its erection is unknown, the Great Hill Road boundary marker is significant for its associations with the history of Barnstable's boundary establishment. It possesses integrity of location, design, setting, materials, workmanship, feeling and association and meets criterion A of the National Register of Historic Places.
