DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Bernard Haas residence is a two-story Queen Anne style house with a truncated hipped roof with protruding gables on each side. The porch, which extends across the north facade and wraps around the east side, has Tuscan columns and pediments. The east and west sides each have a bay window. All major windows and doors have leaded glass transoms. The shingled gables each have a rectangular recess for ornamentation.

Except for aluminum siding on the first story this house remains unaltered on the exterior.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Bernard Haas residence is architecturally significant in Weiser as a good late Queen Anne example. It is one of several fine late Victorian homes in Weiser designed by Tourtellotte and Company, the foremost architectural firm in Idaho in this period. Located at the east end of town it is apart from the major residential section of Weiser, as such it stands as a preeminent local landmark.

Bernard Haas was a pioneer merchant in the Weiser valley having established a mercantile store at Salubria in the 1890s. With the turn of the century he moved to Weiser and assisted his brother Herman in operating the Haas Hardware Store.
