Description

Narrative Description

(Describe the historic and current condition of the property on one or more continuation sheets.)

Located on State Highway 70 (near the town of Daisy) at the point where it crosses between Self Creek and Lake Greeson, the Self Creek Bridge is of the open spandrel deck arch type. It consists of a total of three reinforced concrete spans, the longest of which is 200 feet. Its total length is 692 feet, its deck width is 25.9 feet and its overall width is 31.6 feet. The abutments, the two piers and the open arches that support the deck are all of reinforced concrete construction, as is the deck with its asphalt surface. A relatively elaborate concrete masonry balustrade runs the full length of each edge of the deck.

Significance

Constructed in 1949, the Self Creek Bridge is associated with the Post World War II Era historic context and is of the open spandrel deck arch type. The D.F. Jones Construction Company of Little Rock in conjunction with the Arkansas State Highway Commission erected the bridge for a cost of \$287,624.77. Given its intact condition is retains sufficient integrity to remain associated with its historic period; it is thus locally eligible under Criterion C.

Historic Background

The Lake Greeson (Narrows Dam and Reservoir) project was authorized by the Flood Control act of 1941 as amended in 1944. Construction of the Dam was completed in 1950 with the Self Creek Bridge being completed the year before. Flood control and hydroelectric power were the authorized purposes of the project, though recreational fishing and






