

Describe the present and original (if known) physical appearance

The Newcastle Portuguese Hall is a $36' \ge 68'$ one story recessed store front building of standard wood frame construction. It has a concrete foundation, wood floors and walls and an aluminum gabled roof. It consists of a large meeting room with a small kitchen 7'x 12' on one side of the recessed entrance and a storeroom the same size on the opposite side. Restrooms, 6' x 16' are on the right rear of the building. It has five windows on each side and two in front, with a double door entrance.

It was built 1917-18 by donations raised by the Portuguese families in the area. The head carpenter was Tony Perry. The restrooms were added on the back of the building in 1922, and electricity was also installed then. It is situated in a rural setting, formerly a fruit orchard.

In 1930, when Highway #40 was widened, the Hall was moved back on the original lot about twelve feet and raised about eight feet but retained its original orientation to the road. Because the highway department built a new multiple wall concrete foundation with extensive cross bracing, this move served to preserve the structural integrity of the hall. Today the building is straight and true. The floors are flat and level.

The Hall is in need of extensive rehabilitation. It needs painting inside and out. An outside wall needs repair. The restrooms need repairs and /or rebuilding. The floors need refinishing. We have already painted the front of the building and hung a new sign. We will continue restoration work as funds become available.

Statement of Significance (in one paragraph)

The Newcastle Portuguese Hall was built by Portuguese families in 1918, on land donated by Manuel Perry and his sister, Mary Z. Perry, Portuguese-Americans. The 60th by 108th lot was donated to the three Portuguese Societies of Newcastle for a meeting hall. These fraternal societies enriched the lives of the individuals with their meetings and social activities. The hall served as a social center to remind their children of their Portuguese heritage and customs. The familiar "Chamarrita" or folk dance kept their old culture alive. It has been in constant use over 60 years for meetings and many other activities. The Portuguese-Americans started immigrating to this county in the mid 1800's. They came to the gold fields, worked on the railroads, became dairymen and successful fruit orchardists. We feel this hall should be registered in the National Register of Historic Places program in honor of the early day Portuguese-American pioneers.

The three lodges, "Irmandade do Divino Espirito Santo" -- IDES --Brotherhood of the Divine Holy Spirit, "Uniao Portuguesa do Estado da California" -- UPEC -- Portuguese Union of the State of California, "Sociedade Portuguesa Rainha Santa Isabel" -- SPRSI -- Saint Isabel Portuguese Women's Society, are all devoted to preserving Portuguese culture and tradition, most notably the Holy Spirit Festas held annually each May and June throughout California. The membership of these three lodges has over the years been comprised principally, if not exclusively of Portuguese-Americans, Portuguese speaking citizens of Placer County and their descendants.

Since 1918 these three Portuguese-American lodges have:

- -- held their regular meetings and celebrated their anniversary meeting in this Hall.
- -- held "Chamarrita" or folk dances featuring fado music and Portuguese musicians in this Hall.
- -- held fund raisers, card parties and seasonal celebrations such as Christmas and New Year's parties in this Hall.
- -- held bridal and baby showers and christening parties in this Hall.

Recently, the Placer County Chapter of the Sacramento Portuguese-American Historical Committee has been meeting in the Hall. We feel the preservation and restoration of this building is of the utmost importance. We will begin restoration work as funds become available.
