Description

The Housing Storage Supply Warehouse (S-726) was constructed in December 1941, by the Del E. Webb Construction Company. The building was constructed using a standard utilitarian design with Minimal Traditional architectural style influences and as such is a good representation of the Military Facility property type. It retains substantial integrity of design, materials, workmanship, and association. The building is currently unoccupied.

The Supply Warehouse is located on "A" Street along the south fringe of the original base plan, where most warehouses were originally located. It is now the only building on the block.

The Warehouse is a rectangular, one-story building of wood frame construction and measures 150 feet long by 60 feet wide. The building is constructed with a raised wood frame floor supported by concrete foundation walls and piers. The gable roof is covered with rolled asphalt. It has a concrete foundation. The walls are sheathed with wood shiplap except at the south facade were the sheathing has been changed to T1-11 plywood.

Exterior features include original loading dock doors and loading docks. There are eight sliding loading dock doors. Four are original wood batten doors, located evenly on the north facade. The other four are metal sliding doors, located on the south facade. At each of the four dock doors on the south facade, there is a loading dock constructed of wood.

Despite sheathing and loading dock door modifications on the south elevation, the warehouse retains sufficient integrity of design, materials, and workmanship to convey its historic identity in terms of design and function. It is the most intact example of a standard warehouse building existing on the base.

Statement of Significance

The Housing Storage Supply Warehouse is significant under *Criteria A* under the areas of Community Planning and Development and Military. Built in December 1941, the Housing Storage Supply Warehouse is significant for its association with the initial development and construction at Williams Air Force Base. It represents the best illustration of a typical military support building once common at the field. The Housing Storage Supply Warehouse is also significant under *Criteria C* under the area of significance of Architecture. It is a good illustration of its type, period, and method of construction. It is representative of the historic contexts "Williams Field Base Facilities, 1941 to 1944," and "Williams Field Base Plan and Architectural Theme, 1941 to 1944." Built of a standard military design by the Del E. Webb Construction Company, the Housing Storage Supply Warehouse represents the Military Facility property type.

The Housing Storage Supply Warehouse was part of the first phase of development at Williams Field which took place between August 1941 and February 1942. This initial development included the construction of 146 buildings and structures, runway construction and flood control, and drilling a water well with a storage and supply system. The contract for the construction of the buildings and structures was awarded to the Del E. Webb Construction Company for the amount of \$1,534,021.00. The

structure is one of four remaining buildings at Williams Air Force Base that functioned originally a warehouse for military supplies or equipment to support base facilities.

The Housing Storage Supply Warehouse is a good illustration of its type, period, and method of construction. As the least altered of the four remaining original warehouses, the building exemplifies the standard design and stylistic theme associated with its type. The building continues to convey its Minimal Traditional stylistic image as well as its identity as a warehouse. It retains its original rectangular plan and gabled roof with cornice molding, most of the horizontal shiplap siding, the wood double hung six over six lite windows, and the wood batten loading dock doors. The building is a good illustration of the Military Facility property type and retains its integrity of design, materials, workmanship and location. It conveys the physical characteristics of the property type, including its overall design, use of materials and method of construction. Those characteristics distinguish it from later military architecture, and visually provides an associative link to the initial development of the base and its significant role during World War II. The warehouse possesses the associative quality that connects it to the history of Williams Air Force Base. In particular, the building conveys its function as a warehouse and therefore as an integral component of the base's original , World War II-era infrastrucure. It is a good illustration of the rapid development of the base and the comprehensive operations needed to fulfill its purpose of providing flying military training during World War II.
