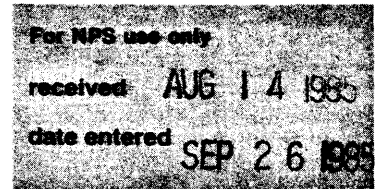

7. Description: Stuccoed foundation, stuccoed adobe walls; corrugated metal over wood shingle roof; wood shingles on dormer; small enclosed eaves with frieze boards; 3/1, 4/4 double-hung windows; wood surrounds with molding cornices (single door and front windows); chamfered porch posts with cut-out brackets. Located in a depression beside **Arroyo de Manteca** one block northwest of the **Old Town Residential Historical District**.

8. Significance: Elements of the folk tradition are overshadowed here by popular trends. The adobe construction, simple wooden details and narrow dormer place it in the local tradition. Symmetrical openings, implied center hall plan and hipped roof come from turn-of-the-century classicism. The unbroken sweep of the roof out over the porch is noteworthy--probably a folk builder's interpretation of this new roof type.
