The nominated property consists of a rectangle, 21 feet wide by 22 feet long, whose vertices coincide with the outside corners of the bridge abutments at each end of the bridge, and includes only the bridge superstructure and substructure.

Boundary Justification: See continuation sheet.

Because the bridge is located on a public road, there are no legal boundary lines for the ends of the bridge. Therefore, these boundaries are drawn to encompass only the superstructure and substructure of the bridge itself.

Spanning a small inlet at the southwest corner of Lake Cochrane in the northeast corner of Norden Township, the Old Cochrane Road Bridge is an abandoned highway structure that once carried a local, unpaved road around the lake. After this road was rerouted slightly to the west of the bridge, the structure passed into private ownership. It is currently part of a lakeside parcel that includes a cottage immediately to the south. The structure is a single-span stone-arch bridge built of unworked fieldstone, primarily granite. Springing about 4 feet above grade, the arch spans about 6 feet. The stonework is quite crude, displaying heavily mortared joints at least 2 inches in width. The arch vault is coated with a concrete sheath bearing formwork impressions, indicating that the voussoirs were probably laid up dry on the centering and then covered by a pouring of concrete -- a standard technique for rural stone-arch bridge construction in the early twentieth century. Although in deteriorating condition, the structure retains good integrity.

8. Significance

Old Cochrane Road Bridge is being nominated to the National Register of Historic Places as part of the "Historic Bridges in South Dakota" Multiple Property Nomination. It is related to the historic context of "Historic Bridges in South Dakota, 1893-1943" and is classified with the associated property type for masonry arch bridges. This bridge is individually eligible for the National Register under Criterion C as the only surviving example of a stone arch built prior to the New Deal program. The bridge retains good integrity.

The date of construction for the Old Cochrane Road Bridge has not been determined, but the Deuel County Commissioners Records indicate that the county built at least one other stone-arch highway bridge during the first decade of the twentieth century. Given its type of construction, the Old Cochrane Road Bridge probably dates from the same period.

The Old Cochrane Road Bridge is South Dakota's only known, surviving example of a stone-arch highway bridge constructed prior to the New Deal era. Among the 11 stone arch bridges inventoried in South Dakota, ten of them were built during the New Deal era. All of these are located in Turner County, where approximately 185 masonry-arch bridges survive as a result of a massive New Deal masonry-arch construction program.
