DISCUSSION AS REQUIRED:

Constructed between 1909 and 1915, this building was first used as a grocery and printing office. Later used as the U.S. Post Office; it was occupied by the newspaper the Arizona State Miner in 1940. It is one of the few commercial buildings in Wickenburg from the 1910-1920 period to have survived without substantial facade alterations. Physical evidence indicates the windows to be original features.
