ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION: entablature with modillions, main first floor entrance on 12th Street boasts terra cotta work around second floor palladian windows; situated in Central Business District with one 4-story building and primarily two and three story buildings around it; no landscaping, fair condition.

AREAS OF SIGNIFICANCE: entablature is Sullivanesque in its organic nature. Commercial: Serving since about 1896 as a commercial office building, the Empire Building has become a local landmark, one of the tallest buildings in Columbus, it has housed the offices of numerous leading doctors, lawyers and businessmen.
