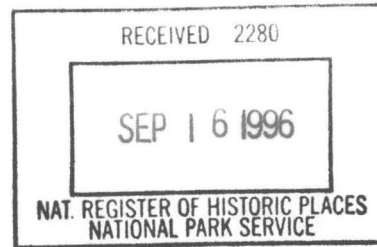

Description

The Myers House (at 221 St. Andrew's Terrace) is a two-and-one-half story, wood frame and brick masonry residence designed in a synthesis of the Craftsman and Prairie styles. The main two-story block of the house is fundamentally rectangular, though its design is augmented with a single-story hipped sunroom on its southern elevation and a 2/3 porch at its northeast corner, supported upon brick columns. The asphalt shingle hipped roof features a total of three broad dormers on each of its eastern, northern and southern slopes, as well as a single-story, hipped bay projecting from the northern elevation directly below the dormer. The single-story hipped rear section appears to have been modified at some point, possibly by the filling of an originally open porch. One tall brick chimney rises next to the southern wall, and another rises through the western or rear slope of the main hipped roof. The windows throughout are largely one-over-one wood frame, and the entire structure is supported upon a continuous brick foundation.

Significance Criterion C, local significance

The Myers House (at 221 St. Andrew's Terrace) is locally significant under Criterion C by virtue of its status as the best example of a combination of the Craftsman and Prairie styles in West Helena. Constructed just south of the ninety-degree turn at the eastern end of Plaza Avenue in one of the residential areas of the city developed slightly later than those sections immediately to the west, it is associated with the historic context *Historic Resources of West Helena, Arkansas, 1900-1945* as one of the few surviving historic homes with any degree of integrity, and as the best known extant example of this synthesis of popular national styles.

ABSTRACT/SUMMARY COMMENTS:

The Myers House is significant under National Register criterion C (Architecture), as an excellent local example of early twentieth century residential construction. Completed circa 1920, the two-story brick home is a handsome well-preserved combination of Craftsman and Prairie-style architectural forms that recall the prosperity of West Helena's boom period (1910-1930).
