CHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:	NAME: St. Patrick Catholic Church Diocese
Three-bay brick church constructed on a modified cruciform plan with an apse at the northern end. Double-leaf doorway with lancet panels is set in a compound four-centered arch at the first level of a four-story square tower which has round-arch balustrade with tall, pyramidal pinnacles at the corners. Lancet windows on all facades are set in compound pointed arches in slightly recessed bays with corbel tables. Gabled facades have corner buttresses, front and transept gables are parapeted with blind arcades. TEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: Catholic missionaries were a group of Meridian's earliest settlers, coming to the area in 1853 from Paulding Co. Their first church was erected at this site in 1866 and a rock from St. Andreu's Church, IX Century, Lavandieu, France, has been incorporated into the cornerstone. Father Louis Vally, the church's pastor, came to Meridian in 1868 and was one of city's most noteworthy early citizens. He organized the first fire-fighte brigade, helped obtain the convent in 1877, and worked continually during the yellow fever epidemic of 1878, calling on the sick and burying the dead. He was responsible for building the present church in 1886, and because of his outstanding record as a citizen, the City granted permissio for him to be buried in the church yard, the only grave in Meridian outside a cemetery.
