4. Owner: Bernadine Thompson, 500 White Avenue, Aztec, N.M.

7. Description: Stone foundation; clapboard over wood frame; decorative wood shingles; lathe-turned columns with cut-out brackets; two large windows with transoms.

Porch floor and column removed. Located on a street corner in a residential area, one block north of the proposed residential district.

8. Significance: Built around 1908, this is a nicely detailed, if small, Queen Anne style house. Its simple asymmetry is complemented by such stock Queen Anne details as the slender porch columns and cut-out brackets. Alternating bands of pointed and hexagonal wood shingles enliven the gables and porch sides. The wood shingled window bay is yet another attempt to add variety and distinction with limited means.
