construction with brick nogging. It is one of only 4 frame center-passage plans identified from the early 19th century period (1810-40). Features of significance remain intact in spite of alterations to the covering of the framing. These are the form and building material. 45. Description and House Plan: (continued)

Interior:

Reeded trim with bull's eye corner blocks in center passage, high molded baseboards, interior largely intact.

Outbuildings:

Included in the nomination is a contributing root cellar. It is of significance as illustrating popular regional food storage techniques and the original function of the domestic space. The boundaries enclose two contributing buildings.
