Bridge no. 17-289-107 is located 5.0 miles south of the junction of US Highway 16 and carries SD Highway 87 over French Creek. The 70 foot, concrete barrel deck arch span sits on a solid concrete pier and two solid concrete abutments with wing walls. The deck is concrete with an asphalt wearing surface. The two barrel arches are poured concrete with evidence of the board forms. The spandrels and railings of the bridge are uncoursed stone. The arches are accentuated by the use of larger stones set out slightly from the stone veneer.

The bridge retains excellent integrity.

Bridge no. 17-289-107 is being nominated to the National Register of Historic Places as part of the "Historic Bridges in South Dakota" Multiple Property Nomination. It is related to the historic context of "Historic Bridges in South Dakota, 1893-1943" and is classified with the associated property type for reinforced concrete highway bridges. This bridge is individually eligible for the National Register under Criterion A for its association with the Civilian Conservation Corps, a New Deal program designed to provide work relief for the nation's unemployed during the Great Depression of the 1930s. The bridge retains excellent integrity.

President Roosevelt's New Deal programs of the 1930s, ushered in a new era of bridge construction in the South Dakota. The primary intent of these programs was to provide federal assistance to put as many men to work as possible during a time of severe economic crisis, the Great Depression. For bridge projects, in general, federal agencies paid for labor, while the state or local highway departments paid for supervision, engineering, and materials. The labor force for some bridge projects was provided by the Civilian Conservation Corps, a New Deal program established to create work relief for young men between the ages of 18 and 25.

Bridge No. 17-289-107 was built by the Civilian Conservation Corps in 1937. Concrete and stone masonry structures such as this bridge, were typically built at this time because they generated more labor-intensive projects than steel bridges.
