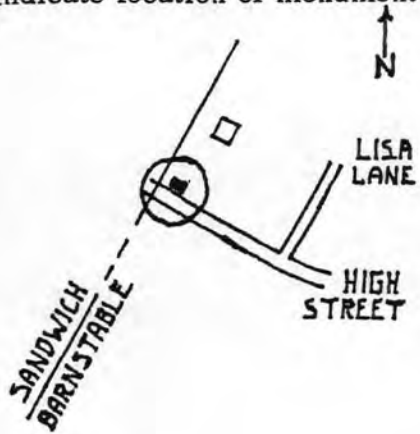

The stone marks the boundry line between the Towns of Barnstable and Sandwich. The letter B on the right side of the vertical line chiseled up the middle of the marker, stands for the Town of Barnstable. The letter S on the left side stands for the Town of Sandwich. The date of its erection is presently unknown.

The marker is located on the boundry line between the Towns of Barnstable and Sandwich basically set when the settlers purchased most of what is now West Barnstable from the Indian Chief Serunk in 1644.
