## 19. HISTORY (Continued)

The Lancaster Woman's Club purchased this property from Dr. Rodney Johnston (who owned the property a very short time) in 1974. Much research was done by the Lancaster Woman's Club and some restoration work accomplished. In 1980 the property was sold to Drs. Peter Powers, Dr. Colin Raitier, and Dr. Steven Royse who opened the Lancaster Family Health Center. In August 1983 this building was sold to the present owner Dr. Nicholas Martin.

The log portion (two story) was covered with a beaded clapboard and two additional rooms were build of brick (dining room and kitchen) probably in the 1850s. The kitchen contains a large fireplace for cooking with the original crane. Another two rooms and bath were added in the 1920s to the older portions of the house and is under a separate roof.

When the house was converted to a medical facility the older portions of the house were not altered, just the latest addition was converted into three examining rooms.


