DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Located in the southwest corner of Deer Park, Garrett County, Pennington Cottage stands on the northwesterly side of Deer Park Hotel Road, east of the intersection of Deer Park Hotel Avenue.

Recently restored, Pennington Cottage is a late nineteenth century Shingle Style frame structure, two and one-half stories high. It has a gambrel roof and a one-story porch that stretches across the principal facade (south side) and along portions of the east and west sides. As the style name implies, the house is entirely covered with dark wood shingles. The roof has recent asphalt shingles. The principal facade has a large double door entranceway with rectangular sidelights and transom. On the second floor is a pair of windows in the western half and a two-story bay window of three sides on the east portion. The third-story of the front has a five-part Palladian design window grouping consisting of four windows with a center oval fan wood panel and a louvered round arch top and keystone. The principal windows of the house have double-hung wooden sashes with multiple lights. The front porch has double turned columns and a baluster with small closely arranged balusters. A two-story, three bay stairwell projects from the west side.

The interior, with the classically influenced, natural trim characteristic of the style, has approximately four rooms per floor with a large entrance hall inside the main door. Like the exterior, the interior was sympathetically refurbished in recent years. The principal original fixtures of the bathrooms remain.

The house is structurally sound, in excellent condition, and basically unaltered.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Pennington Cottage, a late nineteenth century Shingle Style house, was built as a part of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad's Deer Park Hotel complex. The B & O began developing Deer Park as a summer resort in the late 1870's with the construction of a large hotel (circa 1879). Later, a series of individual houses or cottages were erected along a semicircular drive on the hotel grounds. Some of the separate cottages were for the exclusive use of a particular family. Pennington Cottage was the summer home of Josias Pennington (18 -1929), a Baltimore architect.

Pennington and his partner, Ephram Baldwin, are noted for the restoration and addition to the old State House at Annapolis, Maryland. The firm did quite a bit of work for the B & O Railroad and is thought to have designed most of the buildings at the Deer Park Hotel.

Pennington purchased the property from the railroad in 1917 (Deed Book 74, p. 293). The hotel was closed in 1929 and most of the buildings were abandoned. Tradition says that the Pennington family never returned to Deer Park to live after about 1919. The property was sold for taxes in 1933 (Deed Book 105, p. 358). When the present owners purchased the property in 1963, the house was in drastic need of repair. The Faulkners initiated a restoration project, doing much of the work themselves.

Pennington Cottage is the only one of the few remaining hotel cottages to be restored. It contains numerous pieces of original furniture left in the house when it was abandoned by the Pennington family. The house is a prime example of what the private sector can do to preserve our heritage.
