The Nelson House (at 303 St. Andrew's Terrace) is a two-and-one-half story, wood frame and brick masonry residence designed in the traditional vernacular idiom known as the American Foursquare. Typical of this type, the building is designed around a fundamentally square two-story block that also features a full-width single-story front porch (and a modern projecting, single-story, hipped roof ell on the rear or western elevation). Also characteristic of this style, minimal Colonial Revival ornament appears in the frequent use of pediments throughout the design. The windows are largely nine-over-one wood frame, though an assortment of other smaller fixed windows also appear. A brick chimney rises next to the southern wall just to the west of the front elevation, and the modern rear ell also includes a wide brick flue. The asphalt shingle roof and brick walls are supported upon a continuous brick foundation.

Significance

Criterion C, local significance

The Nelson House (at 303 St. Andrew's Terrace) is locally significant under Criterion C by virtue of its status as the best example of an American Foursquare-type house in West Helena. Constructed just south of the ninety-degree turn at the eastern end of Plaza Avenue in one of the residential areas of the city developed slightly later than those sections immediately to the west, it is associated with the historic context Historic Resources of West Helena, Arkansas, 1900-1945 as one of the few surviving historic homes with any degree of integrity, and as the best known extant example of this popular traditional house type.



The Nelson House is significant under National Register criterion C (Architecture), as an excellent local example of early twentieth century residential construction. Completed circa 1915, the 2½-story brick home is a handsome well-preserved example of the American Foursquare building form. Detailed in the Colonial Revival style, the house recalls the prosperity of West Helena's boom period (1910-1930).
