DESCRIPTION

The Shiloh House is a very large residence which boldly exploits the bungalow style. An expansive one-story porch spans the front facade in four wide bays, the fourth bay at the right forming a carport. Composite columns of red brick piers and wood box shafts support the porch roof. A brick balustrade connects the piers. The main house covered by a low-pitch gabled roof rises one-story higher than the deep porch. A red brick outside-end chimney is centered on this front gable and is flanked by three, two-over-one double-hung windows on each side. The site slopes down steeply toward the rear of the house, resulting in the back half of the large bungalow becoming three-stories high. Wide roof overhangs with bracketing and exposed rafter ends are included in the bungalow features.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Criterion: C Area of significance: architecture

The Shiloh House, built in 1927, is an unusually bold statement using the bungalow theme. By virtue of its great size and its ingenious and logical adaptation to the steep site, it must be declared outstanding among the significant number of quality bungalows built in Benton County during the 1920's.
