


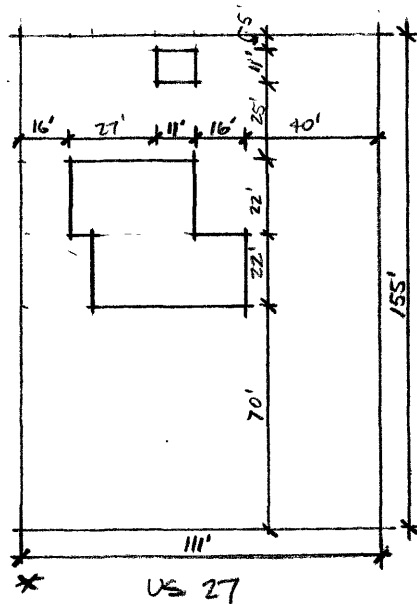

Verbal Boundary Description Acreage .4

Beginning at a point in the east right of way of US 27; then northeast 155 feet to a point; then southeast 111 feet to a point; then southwest 155 feet to a point; then northwest 111 feet along the right of way of US 27 to the point of beginning.

The point of beginning is 70 feet southwest and 16 feet northwest of the southwest corner of the Parke-Moore House.
