Amendment to the Central High School Neighborhood Historic District

(Boundary Increase)

Description

This amendment seeks to add a single contributing building to the existing Central High School Neighborhood Historic District. It thereby increases the number of contributing buildings within the district from 417 to 418.

Built in 1906, the Wright Avenue Christian Church (now known as the Church of the Living God), located at 1850 S. Park Street (the southwest corner of the intersection of Park and Wright Avenues), is a single-story, wood frame church building designed in a unique synthesis of the Greek Revival and Gothic Revival styles. Its fundamentally rectangular plan is augmented only by a later, relatively small Craftsman style front porch, and a c. 1958 rear addition that projects from its western end. Its asphalt shingle roof and weatherboarded walls all rest upon a foundation that is composed of both brick piers and continuous sections.

Significance

Criterion C, local significance

The Wright Avenue Christian Church is architecturally unique as one of the latest known manifestations of the Greek Revival style in Little Rock, and possibly the only known example of one that blended this style with the Gothic Revival. Its immediate proximity to the southwestern boundary of the Central High School Neighborhood Historic District -- a neighborhood of which it was historically a part -- makes it only logical to expand the boundary to include this building.

It is also worthy of note that in the non-historic period, this property has become the home of an African-American congregation that has used, maintained and preserved this building for the last several decades.

The Central High School Neighborhood Historic District is amended to include the historic Wright Avenue Christian Church, which was a important focal point for cultural activity in the neighborhood The modest wood-frame structure is compatible with the existing properties in the district in terms of materials, design, period of construction, and historic use. The original nomination noted several local churches that were an integral part of the neighborhood development in the West End of Little Rock. The Wright Avenue Christian Church contributes to the district's ability to convey the scale and importance of community development activities in the West End/Central High School neighborhood during the early twentieth century.










