18. Description

Shingle covered barn, of 2-story height with single story shed ell, converted to studio-garage complex, with full height studio window and fieldstone foundations. Similar to a coastal Maine barn in feeling, proportions and gray color. Stone walls, similar to barn foundations, enclosed terrace and front lawn to south and extend to small gazebo. Across drive but not included in nomination is 1-story, white clapboard, "Cape" style house, L-shaped, with dormers and prominent chimney. Sweeping views of Peterborough hills.

19. History

Originally built as a barn probably in 1790's by Samuel Fisk (1768-1844) whose farm homestead was in this location after 1791, and used principally as a sheep barn by the Fisk family, who owned the farm until 1882. Remodelled as a studio with garage addition in 1929 for L.C. Gerry by architect Albert Harkness of Providence, R.I. (designer of the County Courthouse there) who also added studio windows and dance floor at that time.

20. Significance

Example of late 18th century farm architecture, which suitably evolved due to Dublin's role as art colony--its successful conversion the work of Providence R.I architect Albert Harkness.




