DESCRIPTION

The Stockton Building, located at 113 North Broadway in Siloam Springs, is a two-story late 19th century vernacular commercial building. Constructed of load bearing stone, the building retains its ornamental pressed metal cornice. The cornice is also a parapet which is horizontal across the outer two bays and pedimented in the middle emphasizing the center bay. There are three windows on the second level covered by metal awnings. The storefront has been altered.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Criterion: C Area of significance: architecture

Originally built as a hardware/grocery/print shop, the Stockton Building is presently used as a dentist's office. Constructed in 1894, it is the only building of its type remaining in downtown Siloam Springs. The elaborate cornice is unique in the community. Together with the other details of the building, the decorative cornice makes the Stockton Building representative of its period of significance: late 19th century vernacular commercial architecture.
