



Historic Sites Survey

ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION:

One-story, irregularly massed, turn-of-the-century frame cottage on corner lot facing west. Moderately-pitched hipped roof with a gable projection and a four-bay pavilion at the southwest corner. Main entrance is a single door with transom. A single four-over-four double-hung sash completes fenestration. L-shaped porch from western to northern facade leads to secondary entrance, a single door with transom. Iron posts and balusters; rectangular vent and decorative woodwork in the front gable. Two exterior chimneys. Recently built gazebo includes scenes of Magnolia on ceiling panels. Similar to its neighbors 515 and 550 North Cherry.

ALTERATIONS:

Original wooden balustrade replaced with iron posts and balusters.

OUTBUILDINGS:

Gazebo

LANDSCAPE FEATURES:

On residential street with well-maintained landscaping and many magnolia and other trees.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:

The George Chadwick House, 560 North Cherry, along with its almost identical neighbors at 515 and 550 North Cherry, is a highly-articulate example of an intricately-detailed, middle-class, turn-of-the-century cottage in Magnolia. The three closely grouped residences maintain a perfect scale and relationship along North Cherry Street, and both individually and collectively, are significant for their historic streetscape, attention to Eastlake detail, and high degree of preservation. These cottages are the smallest extant residences constructed during Magnolia's turn-of-the-century building boom and show an extraordinary commitment to the decorative details expressed in Magnolia's magnificent Queen Anne residences.

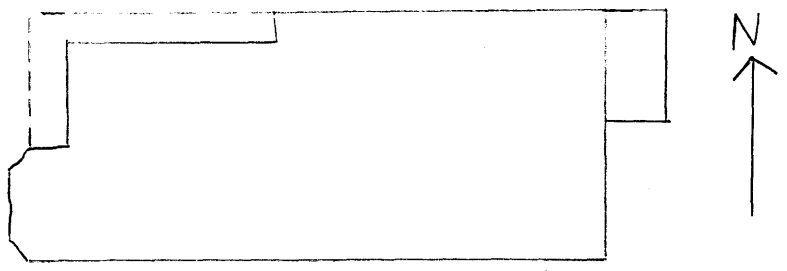
