VERBAL BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION & JUSTIFICATION

Beginning at A in the NW corner of the yard, thence with fence around yard E 100 ft to B, S 125 ft to C, W 100 ft to D, N 125 ft to the beginning containing the house and tool shed - about 1/4 acre. The house is located on a 110 acre stock and tobacco farm bordered by S Ephron on the N and Hwy. 1685 on the E. Barns on the farm are later.
