Describe the present and original (if known) physical appearance

The How Family Historic District comprises three architecturally and historically significant buildings. Dating from 1799 to 1818, none of the buildings has undergone major alterations. The district is residential.

Buildings contributing to the character of the district:

- Daniel How House (23 Danforth Street): 1799, Federal, 2¹/₂ stories, brick with granite trim, gabled roof, four end chimneys, Doric entrance with fanlight. (N.R. 4/23/73)
- John How House (40 Pleasant Street): 1817, Federal, 2¹/₂ stories, brick with granite trim, gabled roof, four end chimneys, arched recessed entrance with fan and sidelights.
- Joseph How House (30-32 Pleasant Street): 1818, Federal double house, 3¹/₂ stories, brick, gabled roof, four end chimneys, arched recessed entrances with fans and sidelights.

There are no nonconforming intrusions within the district.

The one story flat roofed brick building to the west of the John How House is not attached to it and is not within the district.

Statement of Significance (in one paragraph)

Specific dates 1799, 1817, 1818

Daniel How, a hatter originally from Methuen, Massachusetts, came to Portland in 1795 and three years later married Abigail Mussey, daughter of Benjamin Mussey. The following year he built his home on his father-in-law's land at what is now 23 Danforth Street. (N.R. 4/23/73).

Builder/Architect

At the time of the marriage of his second son, John, Daniel How erected as a wedding gift the handsome seven room Federal house on the back of his property facing on Pleasant Street (No. 40). In addition to the recessed fan doorway there is a beautiful hanging staircase and all seven rooms have working fireplaces.

The following year Daniel's brother, Joseph erected the double house at 30-32 Pleasant Street beside that of his nephew. There are two fireplaces on each of the three full floors on both sides of this very large house, making twelve in all.

When the Daniel How House was built, Commercial Street did not exist and from the elevated location on Danforth Street it commanded an unobstructed view of Cape Elizabeth, the islands, and the harbor. A few rods from the front steps was a high bank which held back the tide. Now surrounded by later commercial development, the three How Houses exist as a Federal period "island" which recalls the appearance of this section of the city in the years immediately following the War of 1812. All three houses have been recently refurbished and are in excellent condition.
