DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Collier-Barnett House is a single-story frame structure built between 1870 and 1888. The roof is gabled. The main body of the house is rectangular with a projection to the front (east) and one to the rear.

The east projection contains a bay window whose three parts are separated by capitaled pilasters. Above this bay is an ornate and delicately carved attic vent and bargeboards. A porch runs from the east bay across the front and then down the south side. Windows opening onto the porch are four-over-six, floor to ceiling. Porch doors are four paneled. Both windows and doors are faced with interior-type ogee trim and have baseboards.

The rear (west) projection has a shed porch on its north side. This porch is now screened.

The house has a wide freize board and the gable ends are articulated with returns. Windows other than on the porch, have four-over-four lights and pedimented window heads.

The interior of the house is in good condition. Ceilings are fourteen feet tall. The original trim is still in place and the baseboards measure 14 1/2 inches. There are four mantels in the house which are paneled.

The only additions which have been made are the extension of the front porch in 1922 and the construction of a bathroom with modern plumbing on the southwest side of the house. Due to the composition of the long windows opening to the porch and a matching window on the south side of the east projection, it would seem that the original porch was as wide as the east projection and did not turn the southeast corner. Porch posts have been replaced with brick piers.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Collier-Barnett House, located near Altheimer, Arkansas, is one of the few remaining old plantation homes in Jefferson County. It is significant in its association with the Collier family who were prosperous farmers in the area. Architecturally the house is a good example of one of the finer one-story homes built in the 1870's and 1880's. The Collier-Barnett House is in much its original condition and is considered a local landmark.

The house is located in the northeast quarter of Section 3, Township 5 South, Range 8 West. This land has apparently been in the hands of the Collier-Barnett family since 1856.

Nelson J. Phillips, an early settler of Jefferson County, owned about 700 acres in Section 3, Township 5 South, Range 8 West and Section 34 and 35, Township 4 South, Range 8 West. Phillips died between February 14 and April 10, 1855, and his wife, Minerva Jane Phillips, was appointed administratrix of his estate. In October, 1855, Mrs. Phillips petitioned the Probate Court to permit her to sell the land. Although a deed could not be found, one source said Charles E. Collier bought the land from the Phillips estate. Collier assessed and paid taxes on the land in 1857. On May 20, 1869, Asa Shelton, who was serving as trustee for the Phillips heirs, deeded the land to Thomas Henry Collier.

Born in Madison County, Alabama, on April 21, 1837, Thomas Henry Collier was the son of Charles E. and Elizabeth Stuart Collier according to his obituary in the Pine Bluff Daily Graphic. T. H. Collier is said to have come to Arkansas and settled near Altheimer in 1859. During the Civil War, Collier served in Captain Owens Company of the 18th Arkansas Regiment. After the war, he returned to Arkansas and resumed farming. The deed covering the Collier-Barnett House described it as "being all the land embraced in the plantation on which said Thomas H. Collier resided from the year 1855 to 69, inclusive."

Mrs. Tom Phillips, a pioneer resident of the neighborhood, said Nelson Phillips had a log cabin on the present site of the house. After Collier acquired the farm, he lived in the cabin for a time. He married Edna Jordan Jones, the daughter of Dr. Samuel J. Jones, whose land adjoined the Collier plantation, on April 1, 1868. The couple's first child, Thomas J. Collier, was born in the log cabin on July 18, 1870.

The present house was built some time between 1870 and 1880. Their youngest child, Elizabeth, was born in the house on June 28, 1884.

Elizabeth Collier married Richard Stuart Barnett on March 18, 1905, in Little Rock. She inherited the home from her father when he died on January 11, 1919. She left it to her youngest son, Thomas Collier Barnett, when she died on March 9, 1975.

The house was built in the "dog-trot" tradition with a long hall running through the center of the structure. Because it was a finer home, the hall was enclosed instead of being left open as was the case in many less expensive houses.

The Collier-Barnett House has four bedrooms, a dining room, kitchen, parlor, bath and the large hallway which was converted into a sitting room. All of the rooms have fireplaces except the parlor and bath. Four of the original mantels are still in place. The ceilings are 14 feet tall and the baseboards are 18 inches wide. The original doors and windows are still in the house.

At one time a landscape designer from Memphis, Tennessee, was employed to lay out the grounds of the home. He designed walkways in a figure eight on the front lawn of the house with boxwood planted for borders. Five magnolias were included in the plan and a rose garden filled one of the circles. Although the walks are now covered and the roses are no longer there, some of the boxwood remain. Two stones from the old grist mill and T. H. Collier's hitching post are on the front lawn. A small building used as a privy is in the backyard and the old smokehouse still stands in back of the main house. The cotton house which was part of the old gin is west of the main house.



The staff of the Arkansas Historic Preservation Program is preparing a National Register nomination for the above captioned property which will be presented to the Arkansas State Review Committee at their December meeting. The National Register of Historic Places is a listing of historic sites, buildings, objects and districts from all across the country that are worthy of preservation. Entry in the National Register is an honor which places on obligation on a private owner. It does, however, provide protection through comment by the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation from federally financed, assisted or licensed projects that might affect a National Register property.
