

BOUNDARY JUSTIFICATION:

The Vineyard was listed in the National Register of Historic Places on July 22, 1994. It is significant under Criterion C for the architectural character of its rural domestic and agricultural buildings. The previous boundaries for this resource inadvertently included 122 acres of unimproved wooded property (identified as Parcel 339 on the boundary map) which does not contain any resources related to the listed significance. The owners of this parcel were not notified of the pending nomination according to 36 CFR 60, as SHPO staff did not intend to include this unrelated acreage in the nomination. Parcel 339 is to be removed from the nomination. The revised boundaries include 188 acres, encompassing the buildings (concentrated on Parcel 138) within their immediate historic setting (Parcel 336).

BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION:

Nominated property consists of Parcels 138 and 336 on Harford County Tax Map 41. Boundaries are depicted on the enclosed map, dated February 1996.
