DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Rising Sun Tavern was built around 1760 by Charles Washington, youngest brother of George Washington. Rising Sun Tavern is a one-and-a-half story frame building covered with broad hand-beveled clapboards. It is approached by a small, restored stone porch. Its gabled roof is pierced by three tiny dormers and built-in end chimneys. The banquet room includes a paneled corner fireplace and a handsome built-in cupboard. A large ballroom burned to the ground many years ago.

The back yard has been decorated with grape vines and relocated outbuildings. The work there is purely conjectural.

Extensive restoration has recently been done on the interior of the tavern. The old Post Office has been restored. In the process of restoration some of the original railings from the 18th century bar were found under the plaster and the entire bar has now been rebuilt. Chair rails, cornices, paneled fireplace and unique stairway have all been repaired and painted in their original colors. Furniture and accessories all date from the late 18th century. The house is open to the public on an unlimited basis.

## Boundary

The boundaries include all that plot of land owned by the Association for the Preservation of Virginia Antiquities which contains Rising Sun Tavern and the small vineyard to its rear. The boundaries are described by the red line on the accompanying map A, labelled "City of Fredericksburg, Office of Commissioner of Revenue" and last dated 1973.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Rising Sun Tavern was a favorite stopover for southern statesmen on their way from their own colonies to Philadelphia and the Continental Congress. Here, in 1777, George Mason, George Wythe, Edmund Pendleton, Thomas Lee, and Thomas Jefferson outlined the bill that Jefferson later phrased as the Statute of Virginia for Religious Liberty. The Peace Ball, attended by George Washington and his mother, his officers, La Fayette, Rochambeau, de Grasse, and others, in celebration of victory at Yorktown, was held in 1781 in the assembly room, long since burned. John Marshall, Patrick Henry and Hugh Mercer are a few of the other colonial leaders who met at Rising Sun Tavern. The inn ceased to be operated as a place of business sometime prior to the Civil War, and was made an historic shrine following its purchase by the Association for the Preservation of Virginia Antiquities in 1907.
