MEDICINE LODGE PEACE TREATIES

In October, 1867, Klowa.Comanche, Arapahoe, Apache and Cheyonne. Indiana signed peace treaties with the Federal government. 15,000 Indians camped near by during the council, among them. the famous chiefs Sutanta. Little Raven and Black Kettle. 500 soldiers acted as escort for the U.S. commusioners. Interest in this colorful spectacle was no widespread that Eastern papers sent correspondents, among them Heary M Stanky, who later was to find Livingstone in Africa. While the treaties did not bring immediate peace they make possible the coming of the railroads and eventual attiement. The setter of the council was at the confluence of Medicine river and Elm creek. a little southwast of Medicine lodge. Every five years a treaty pagent is pre-meaned in this amphitheater. In Medicine Lodge there is many the mean on the high school grounds.




